

1. What is the recommended attire or dress code for the event?

The dress code is business casual.

2. How do I get to [The Carlu](#)? Is there parking available?

The Carlu is located at [444 Yonge Street, Floor #7](#) in Toronto in the College Park building at the southwest intersection of Yonge and College streets. The elevator that takes guests to the venue is located on the ground level near Tim Hortons. For guests travelling by TTC, the elevator to The Carlu is located on the ground level above College Station.

3. What time do doors officially open and close for the event? When does dinner start?

Click “check out”, add all your guest information, and then finally click register.
